

## Funding Announcements – 41st Parliament (June 2, 2011 – August 2, 2015)

Since my election as your Member of Parliament, it has been my great pleasure to announce federal funding for a wide range of projects that benefit the residents of Kamloops-Thompson-Cariboo. Because the former Conservative government focused on supporting jobs and the economy while paying down the deficit, there were fewer funding announcements in the 41<sup>st</sup> Parliament compared to the previous Parliament. However, I am pleased to let my constituents know what funding came into our riding between 2011 and 2015. With that in mind, below is a breakdown of funding by program, including the amount of funding and the recipient community.
